About The University:

Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar was founded at Sagar on 18 July, 1946 by the sole initiative and donation of Sir Dr. Harisingh Gour. He was the founder Vice Chancellor of this University and a legal Stalwart and also the first Vice Chancellor of Delhi University. Earlier it was known as University of Saugor and became a Central University by the Act of parliament on 15 January, 2009, located on the Vindhyaachal range of mountain. This University has a picturesque location and is the largest University in the Central region and has about 1500 acres of land. It is a modern Central University and has earned A+ grade from National Assessment Accreditation Council, Bangalore. It currently has 11 schools and 39 teaching departments which are well equipped. These school are School of Applied Sciences (SAS), School of Arts and Information Sciences (AIS), School of Biological Sciences (SBS), School of Commerce and Management (SCM), School of Engineering and Technology (EAT), School of Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS), School of Languages (SOL), School of Law (SAL), School of Educational Studies (SES), School of Mathematical and Physical Sciences (MPS), School of Chemical Sciences and Technology (SCT). In addition, this university also has institutions such as Educational Multimedia Research Centre (EMRC), Academic Staff College (ASC) known as Human Resource Development Center. It has a modern library, outdoor & indoor stadiums, auditorium, Sophisticated Instrumentation Laboratory (SIL), Department of Physical Education, Gyms, Hostels for research scholars, boys and girls. Bank and Post office, residential quarters for teachers and employees, and a hospital.

The Department of Economics in the University is involved in teaching Economics perspectives at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels along with facilitating for Ph.D. in this discipline. The Department aims to help students to bridge the gap between economic theory and applications in real life. Globally, the economic sector has been experiencing phenomenal growth and is witnessing dramatic and drastic changes with sophisticated operations, which has led to increased demand for specialized economic practitioners.

The UG and PG programs are developed to meet the increasing demand for specialists in Economics sought by public and private sector organizations. It imparts rigorous training in the area of statistics, mathematics and econometrics. The courses in the program are designed in consultation with renowned subject experts and stakeholders including students and alumni. The Economics programs involves developing students through interactive classes, seminars, guest talks by subject experts, projects, events, and training through workshops.

The department faculty regularly organizes/participates/delivers guest talks in seminars, conferences, training programs, and workshops at national and international levels. Further faculty members are actively involved in research in the fields of Agricultural Economics, Industrial Economics, Development Studies, Labour, Employment, Poverty, Inclusive Development, Education, Health and Environmental Economics.

Research Profile:

As the University is reputed and well known, the Department of Economics also is endeavouring in that direction through syllabus revision, research publications and participation in research related activities and programmes. The areas of research specialisations are fixed and predetermined, as a result every teaching faculty of the department endeavours for carrying out research in the areas of research specialisation. They undertake research in the areas of their research specialisation and get them published in UGC Care listed journals, Scopus indexed journals, Refereed journals, edited books and in the form of separate independent reference books. Currently one of our faculty, Dr Keshav Tekam and Dr. Abhilasha Durgbanshi is working on a major research project funded worth of Rs. 13.34 lakh sponsored by ICSSR, New Delhi titled "The Economy Behind the Production and Consumption of Alcohol by Tribal People of Madhya Pradesh" (Ref. :F.No. 02/131/2022-23/ST/TS/RP, Dated 01.09.2023.

Sagar is a divisional head quarter and well connected by rail and all seasons' roads. It has a moderate climate and temperature normally remains 10-18 0C in winter and 30-45 0C during summer. Monsoon remains active during July — September. Sagar railway station vis mentioned as Saugor in Railway time table. Saugor station is located on Bina-Katni section of West Central Railway. It is directly connected by train to Bina Jn (75 km), Bhopal (215 km), Jabalpur (279 km) and Jhansi (200 km). It has direct train connectivity for Delhi,

Mumbai, Kolkata. Sagar is connected with all season excellent roads with Bhopal (190 km), Jabalpur (185 km), Jhansi (200 km) and Bina (75 km). The nearest airports are Bhopal (200 km), Khajuraho (215 km).
