To decide the number of candidates to be called for interview for the post of Assistant Professor against Advt.No.R/DoFA/2024/Asst.Prof.-01/dated 21-02-2024.

It is informed to the APC that Table-3(A) of Appendix-II of UGC Regulations 2018 stipulates that the number of candidates to be called for interviews shall be decided by the concerned universities. Regulation number 1 of the Vishwavidyalaya passed in year 2015 prescribes that ordinarily, the number of candidates recommended for interview for one post may not exceed ten, and for two posts fifteen and five per post if the vacancies are more provided the number may be exceeded by the Committee for reasons to be recorded. The Academic Programme Committee (APC) in its 46th Emergent Meeting held on 06 Feb. 2023 keeping in view the department-wise number of candidates for the post of Assistant Professors against Advt.DoFA/2022/1615 dated 10 Aug. 2022 after due deliberations resolved to call all eligible candidates for interview. Keeping in view the large number of applications received for the post of Assistant Professors against the instant advertisement it would not be appropriate either to call all the eligible candidates or to restrict the number 10 per post and 15 for 02 posts. Hence, it would be expedient to fix a reasonable number of candidates to be called for an interview.

Resolutions:

The APC after due deliberations resolved to approve the number of candidates to be called for interview category-wise for one post may not exceed 25 and thereafter 10 per post, according to the score obtained as per criteria for shortlisting by the prescribed committee as envisaged in Table-3(A) of Appendix-II of UGC Regulations 2018.

Other matters related to screening of the applications with the permission of the Chair.

Prof. Ajeet Jaiswal, Director of Faculty Affairs, raised the following issues before APC for clarification:

A. Whether under the Teaching/ Post Doctoral Experience as mentioned in clause-7 of Table-3(A) of Appendix-II of UGC Regulations 2018, the mark should be awarded for the experience of Research Assistant/ Research Associate/ Scientist.

Resolutions:

The APC after due deliberations resolved that Post Doctoral Research experience will be considered only after the date of award of Ph.D. Degree. The APC further resolved that the experience of a Research Assistant in a Project before the award of a Ph.D. Degree will not be considered for awarding of marks under clause-7 of Table-3(A) of Appendix-II of UGC Regulations 2018. Teaching experience acquired from the date of registration to date of award of Ph.D. Degree will not be considered. Experience of teaching means the experience acquired

after becoming eligible as Assistant Professor as per prevailing UGC/AICTE, etc, norms, as the case may be.

B. One of the essential qualifications for the post of Assistant Professor in the Dept. of Pharmaceutical Sciences is Registration as a pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act 1948 as amended from time to time, including any succeeding enactments. However, there was no option available on the CU Chayan Portal to fill up this qualification and upload the requisite documents. That's why the candidate could not give information regarding this essential qualification. Whether, it would be appropriate to give a fair chance to the candidates to submit the registration documents issued on or before 15 July 2024 i.e. the last date of online submission.

Resolutions:

The APC after due deliberations resolved to carry out the screening for the post of Assistant Professor, Dept. of Pharmaceutical Sciences with the remark to submit the registration certificate valid on or before 15 July 2024 i.e. the last date of online submission.

C. Whether the Journals that are in the UGC CARE List will only be considered as quality journals and score shall be given thereon as per Table-3(A) of Appendix-II of UGC Regulations 2018?

The APC after due deliberations resolved that while carrying out the screening of the applications, the Journals that are in the UGC CARE List will be considered as quality journals and a score shall be given thereon as per Table-3(A) of Appendix-II of UGC Regulations 2018. The journals that are not in the UGC CARE List but are peer-reviewed or in the old UGC Approved List of Journals will be examined by the Screening Committee consisting of Subject Experts and upon examination, if the said publication is considered as qualitative, score shall be given thereon as per Table-3(A) of Appendix-II of UGC Regulations 2018.
