

Prof. Naveen Kango, DoAA, extended a warm welcome to the Chairperson and all esteemed members, while also explaining the purpose behind convening the Emergent Meeting of the APC. Following this, the agenda items were discussed.

APC:EM:56:01 To consider the Admission in the Four Year Integrated Programme 4-year Integrated programme (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.) in Academic Session 2025-26.

The Dept. of Education of the Vishwavidyalaya, is offering the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) approved 4-year Integrated Programme (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.). In 2024 a public notice has been issued by the NCTE via letter no. NCTE-Reg1022/16/2023-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 05 February, 2024 stating that "The last academic session for admission of students to 4-year Integrated Programme (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.) shall be Session 2024-25. No fresh admissions shall be made in

this course thereafter.” In compliance of the aforesaid notice, the Vishwavidyalaya has not issued any advertisement regarding admission in the said programmes for the academic session 2025-26.

In the meantime, NCTE, New Delhi vide its public notice no. NCTE-Regl012/18/2024-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 06.05.2025 allowed admission in the said programmes for the academic session 2025-26. In the said public notice, it was also stated under point no. 1(ii) that-**“Those Teacher Education Institutions where the recognition/permission for transition from 4-year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. into ITEP has been granted by the Regional Committees of NCTE shall admit the students only in ITEP through National Testing Agency from the year 2025-2026 and not in 4-year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.”** Since ITEP is being offered by the Vishwavidyalaya in current session, now the question arises whether 4-year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. for the academic session 2025-26 shall be continued or not, because the same is not clearly mentioned in the said para of the public notice of NCTE.

It is to inform that the admission to the 4-year Integrated Programme (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.) had been done through CUET Exam. Since the Vishwavidyalaya has not issued any advertisement regarding admission in the said programmes for the academic session 2025-26, following admission process proposed by the Head, Dept. of Education: **Candidates who have appeared in National Common Entrance Test (NCET)-2025 Exam for Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) Courses may be allowed to take admission in 4-year Integrated Programme (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.) based on the NCET-2025 Score due to same nature of Entrance Examination of both the programmes.**


Apart from this, the distribution of seats under Major/Minor subjects in the ITEP B.A.B.Ed, B.Sc.B.Ed. and B.Com.B.Ed. (Secondary Stage) from academic session 2025-26 and Information Bulletin for admission in 4-year Integrated Programme (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.) and Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) are also placed before committee.

Resolution: After due deliberation, the APC resolved to seek clarification from the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi, regarding public notice no. NCTE-Regl012/18/2024-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 06.05.2025 pertaining admissions to the 4-year Integrated Programme (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed.) for the academic session 2025-26.
