



#### How to reach Sagar

Sagar is a focal point of two national highways and many state highways. It is about 190 km from Bhopal on the state highway, about 200 km from Jhansi on NH26, about 180 km from Jabalpur on state-highway, about 70 km from Bina. Sagar is situated between Bina-Katni section on the rail map, 75 Km from Bina Junction and 188 Km from Katni Junction. Nearest airports with regular domestic flights are at Bhopal, Jabalpur and Khajuraho. It takes 3–5 hours by road to these airports.
