

It is informed to the APC that Prof. P.K. Kathal, Department of Applied Geology, Chairperson Recruitment Coordination Board (RCB) for Teaching

Positions will present the issue in detail in Course of Meeting.

Chairperson of the APC invited Prof. P.K. Kathal, Department of Applied Geology, Chairperson Recruitment Coordination Board (RCB) for raising his concerns regarding impending screening of applications received vide above advertisement and also against the advertisement of the Vishwavidyalaya issued on 4.7.2019.

Prof. P.K. Kathal, raised the following issues:

- (i) Research Papers:- In order to conduct screening of the applications smoothly, certain proof and details of the research papers are required from the applicants.
- (ii) Teaching Experience (for the posts of Associate Professor and Professor: While counting of teaching experience, provisions contained in clause 10.0 of UGC Regulations 2018 must be adhered to.
- (iii) Concerned/allied/relevant discipline:- In the process of screening of the applications, the list of allied/ relevant disciplines duly approved by the concerned Board of Studies and School Board and also by the Academic Council before the date of Advertisement should be considered.

Resolutions:

- (i) The APC after due deliberations resolved that the candidates are required to submit the following documents in tabular form:
 - (a) Full reference of the research papers
 - (b) Group Number/Serial Number (if any), ISSN Number as per UGC-Care List and in any previous list of UGC recognized journals.
 - (c) Impact Factor of Journals with proof
 - (d) If the Journal in which the paper has been published is not mentioned in UGC Care List but is a peer reviewed/ referred Journal, its proof is required to be submitted.

Documents submitted vide (a) to (d) above should be duly signed by the candidates.

- (ii) The APC further resolved that the candidates having served in Private/Local Body are required to submit the copy of "Form 16" for each Financial Year of the respective period of the teaching experience claimed by them.
- (iii) Furthermore, the proposal regarding allied/relevant discipline is approved.
- (iv) The University will organize a demo/on-line demo by the expert from the University of Delhi/Allahabad University for the Deans and Heads.
