Minutes of the 5th Emergent meeting of the Academic Program Committee

The Chairman of the Academic Program Committee gave a warm welcome to all the members.

Thereafter, the agenda items were taken up for discussion.

PART-I: ITEMS FROM THE CHAIR

APC:EM:3:1(1): Consideration on research and Academic Contribution (Category III) for minimum APIs as provided in Appendix-III to be applied for the promotion of teachers under career advancement scheme (CAS) in University Departments.

The Chairman informed the Committee that there are pending cases in various departments for promotion from stage 1 to stage 2 (Assistant Professor). It was pointed out that the requirement of the APIs under category III (research and academic contribution) is (i) 10/year and (ii) 40/assessment period.

Resolution:

The Committee resolved that under category III (research and academic contribution) the minimum APIs of 40/assessment year will be applicable for the assessment period.

It further resolved that the minimum APIs of 10/year will be applicable for each year under assessment period.

Thus an Assistant Professor for promotion from stage-1 to stage-2 must have atleast 10 APIs/year for at-least 4 (four) years separately.

Explanation:-

If an Assistant Professor with a Ph.D degree has APIs as: year 1:12 APIs, year 2: 9 APIs, year 3: 10 APIs, year 5: 7 APIs, year 6: 5 APIs, year 7: 10 APIs then his/her APIs towards 10/year should be counted for the years 1st, 3rd, 4th and 7th only and his/her promotion could be considered after completion of 7 years

(or the date in the 7th year) when she/he acquires the minimum 10 APIs. The same criteria will be applicable in the cases.

APC:EM:3:1(2): Establishment of Professor B.K. Matilal Chair in Indian Philosophy in the Department of Philosophy. The Chairman informed the Committee that the Indian Council of Philosophical Research as desired to establish Professor B. K. Matilal Chair in Indian Philosophy for the central region in the Department of Philosophy of our University. The University has given its consent for the same.

Resolution:

The Committee took note of the establishment of the Chair and appreciated the effort of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor an this direction.

PART-II: ITEM WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

APC:EM:3:2(1): The Course structure of the programs of various departments to be considered by the Committee on Restructuring of Courses of professional programs.

It was pointed out by the Director, Academic Affairs that the Committee on Restructuring of the Courses for professional programs desires that it should be informed about the exact courses it has to consider for restructuring.

Resolution:

The Committee resolved that all courses that have distinct nature (be it professional or not) should be considered by the committee.

(i) MBA (ii) MCA (iii) M.Pharm. (iv) LL.M. (v) M.Lib. I.Sc. (vi) M.J. (vii) M.Ed. and (viii) M.Tech. (Applied Geology).
