Teaching - Learning Process

The Department is engaged in Under-graduate and Post-graduate teaching and in guiding of research work. Hindustani Music -Vocal & Tabla (one subject of UG) and M.A in Hindustani Music Vocal/Tabla is important course of classical Music. In the year 2009, after being upgraded as Central University, CBCS System has been adopted by the University and this course is being changed second time after adopting CBCS System. The UGC has asked for introduction CBCS System in all the Central and State Universities and also proposed a model syllabus of CBCS System in undergraduate programme and it is being introduced in academic year 2016-17.

EVALUATION SYSTEM
