Admission to Post Graduate and Selected UG Programmes - 2022-23

Admissions in various PG programmes and selected UG programmes (including B.Lib.I.Sc., LL.B. and B.J.) will be given to the candidates according to the merit in **Common University Entrance Test – PG (CUET-PG) 2022,** conducted by National Testing Agency, followed by their verification of eligibility in the respective programme through counselling to be made by the Vishwavidyalaya.

Candidates having supplementary/ATKT/backlog in any annual/semester examination at the time of counselling shall not be granted admission. Provisional admission shall be given only to those students who have appeared in the final year/semester examination of the qualifying examination and their result is awaited. The admission of such students shall be purely provisional and they will have to submit their result latest by 31 October, 2022, failing which their provisional admission will automatically stand cancelled and fee paid by them shall stand forfeited. No representation in this regard shall be entertained at any level. To strengthen the spirit of quality in higher education, the Vishwavidyalaya reserves the right to decide the minimum cut-off marks to qualify based on NTA scores.
