Prof. Kapil Kapoor, Chairman, IIAS Shimla, Concurrent Professor, Department of Sanskrit, JNU, Delhi – 110092.



Prof. Kapil Kapoor is a legendary academican with keen interest in Sanskrit theories and classics and a penchant for the Indian culture and tradition. Prof. Kapoor has the distinction of being appointed as the Concurrent Professor, Special Centre for Sanskrit Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University in the year 2000 (the only Concurrent Professor at JNU). He has held various national and international positions of repute during his long and illustrious academic and literary career of more than 5 decades. The vast experience ranges from being the Dean, School of Language, Literature and Culture Studies to Pro-Vice-Chancellor and then UGC Emeritus Fellow at JNU. Editor-in-Chief of the 11-Volume Encyclopaedia of Hinduism (sponsored by India Heritage Research Foundation, USA) (2012), Chief Editor of the Sahitya Akademi sponsored Encyclopaedia of Indian Poetics, a UNESCO project, under publication, He is a Visiting Professor at the Irish Academy of Cultural Heritages, University of Ulster, U.K., 2005–2009, nominated Member, Advisory Board for India Studies, Trinity College, University of Dublin, he is the member of the governing bodies and Executive Councils of many reputed National and International organisations, including Indian Institute of Advanced Studies (IIAS), Shimla, Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR) and so on.

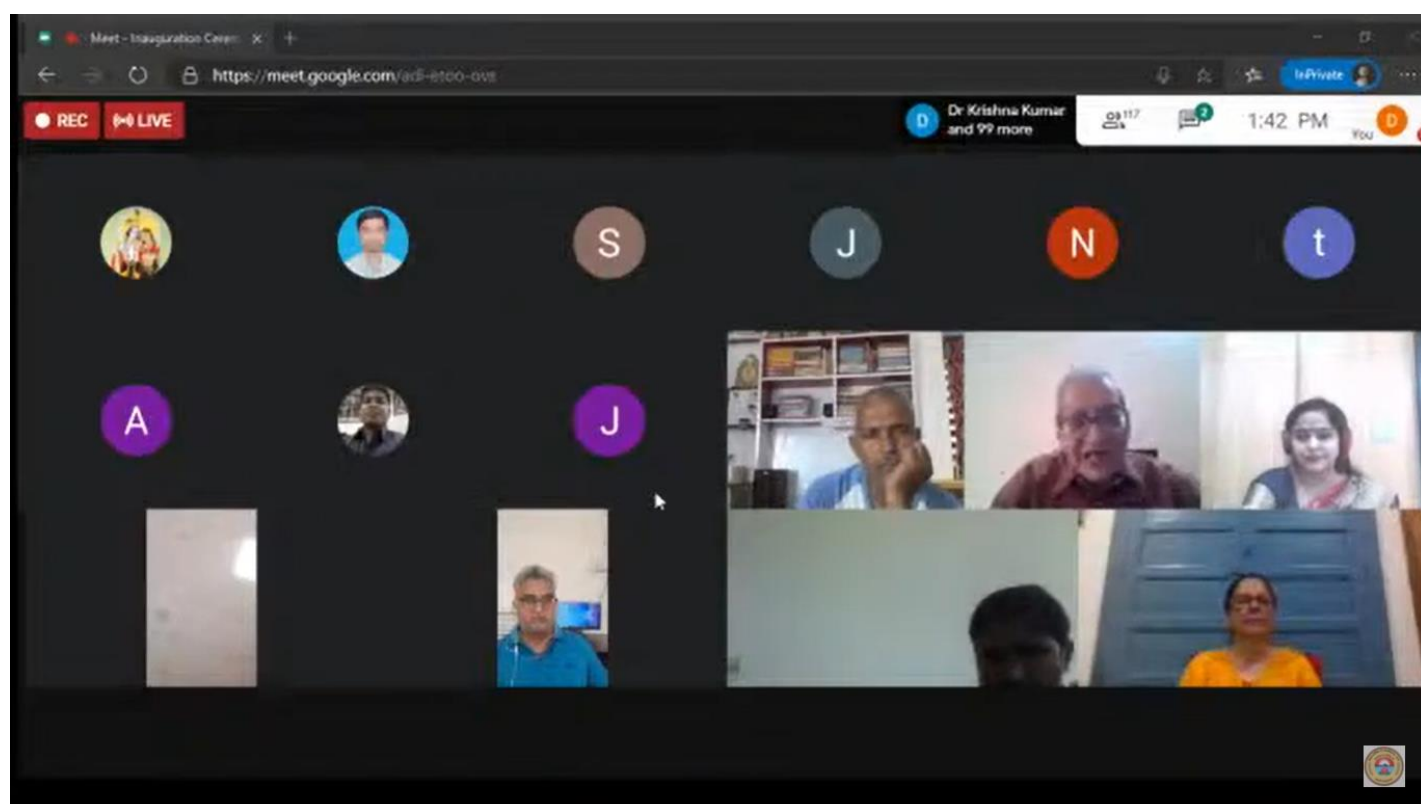
CAPACITY BUILDING FOR TEACHING EFFECTIVENESS

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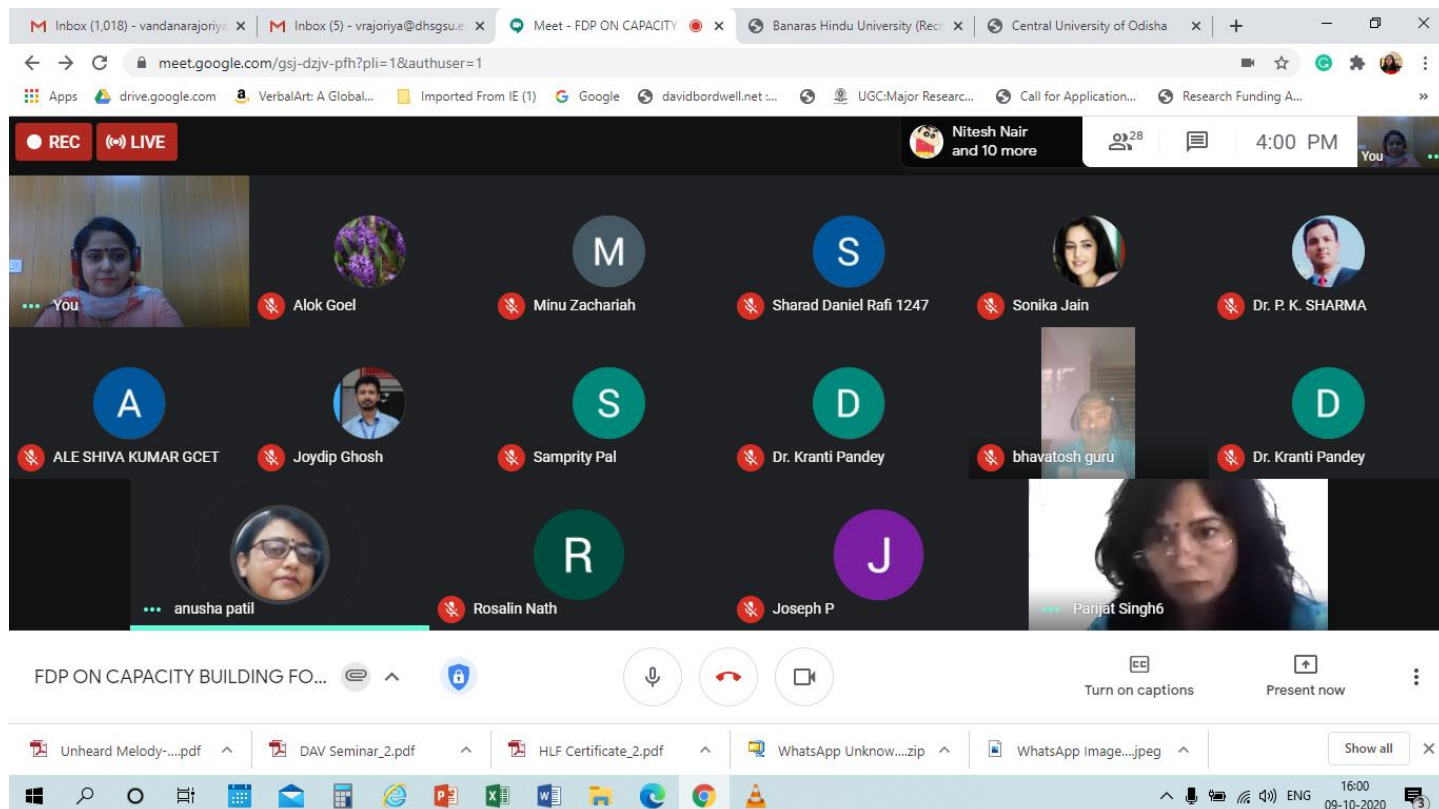
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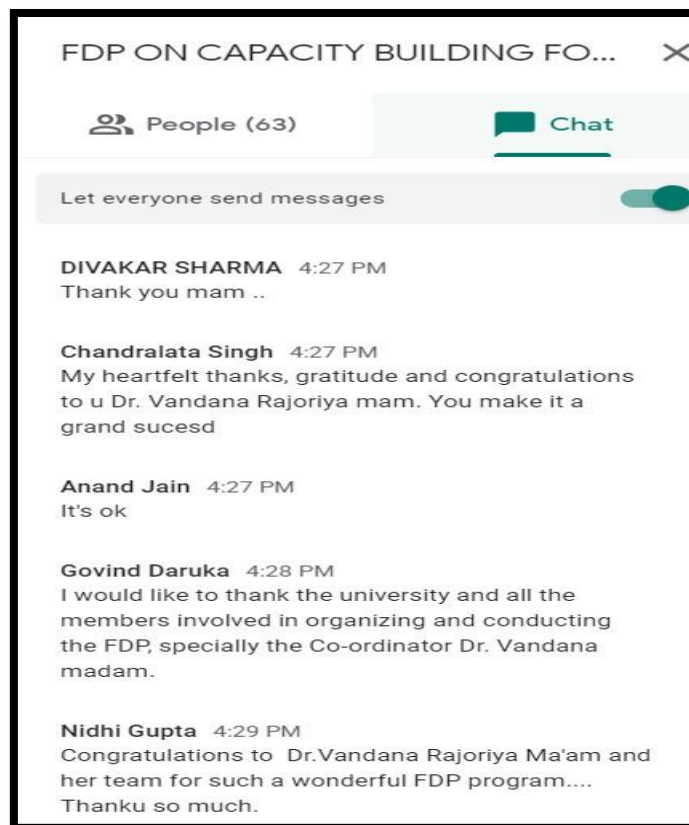
