He has published more than 120 articles in various scientific National and International journals which are often quoted by other researchers. He has travelled extensively and lectured in UK, USA, Spain, Hungary, Sweden, Malta, Germany, France, Canada, New Zeeland, Hong Kong, Australia, Singapore, Taipei, Japan, , UAE, China, Columbia , South Africa, Philipines and Vietnam. 

(20 to 24 September 2021)



All the lectures of the workshop were well received and appreciated by the Participants.


