FC:16:19:4 Rationalization of Cadre Structure of University by UGC:

University Grants Commission, New Delhi vide its letter no. F. NO. 39-1/2016(CU) Vol. II dated 19 June 2018 has communicated the recommendations of UGC Committee on rationalization of Cadre Structure and designations, pay and allowances and rationalization of pay scales of Nonteaching employees of the University. The matter was placed before Executive Council in its 23rd Meeting under Agenda Item no. EC-XXIII-(II)-(x). As per the decision of the EC, the same has been implemented.

The summary of the report on rationalization is as mentioned below:

- a) The cadre strength after rationalization shall be 650. Certain new posts like Dy. Librarian, Assistant Registrar, PRO, Technical Officer, Security Officer, Security Inspectors, Sanitary Inspectors, Sanitary Supervisors, Physiotherapist, Nursing Officer, Horticulturist, etc. have been created.
- b) Number of posts to be abolished as and when vacated by the existing incumbents shall be 209. The redundant posts like Technical (reprographic Unit), Attendant, Chowkidar, Peon, Maid Servant, Mali, Glass Blower, etc. stand abolished.
- c) Number of posts stand abolished with immediate effect is 208. Posts like Sweepers, Chowkidars, Block Servants, Lady Attendant, Peon, Daftri, Mali, Posts in Press and Publications have been abolished and services may be outsourced.



Afterwards the same will be invested on higher rates of interest in Government Sector and PSU to earn better rate of interest for the benefit of employees and compliance of Government of India orders. The decision of investment will be taken as per Investment Policy of University.
