The following agenda were discussed:

- 1) Approval of PG course (Sem I and II) in Biotechnology for - the session 2016-17 onwards.

The syllabus of M.Sc. semester I & II has been approved after due deliberation and necessary changes have been made. The final syllabus has been signed by the members. The approved syllabus will be implemented from 2016-17 onwards.

- 2) Approval of Ph.D course work (one semester) syllabus for - the session 2016-17 onwards

The syllabus of Ph.D (one semester) has been approved after due deliberation and necessary changes (24 credits were changed to 20 credits) have been made. The final syllabus has been signed by the members. The approved syllabus will be implemented from 2016-17 onwards.

- 3) Approval of list of relevant and allied subjects of Biotechnology. - The members agreed upon the list of relevant and allied subjects of Biotechnology that were recommended by the Board of studies meeting held on 31.03.2016.
