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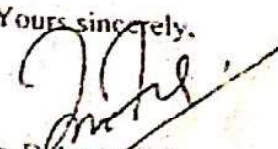
Dear Student,

I am pleased to inform you that you have been selected for the award of Junior Research Fellowship (under Category I) funded by the Department of Biotechnology, GOI, New Delhi, to work with any suitable Investigator in any Research Institute/ University Department where you can register for Ph.D. The admission procedure will be as per the rules and regulation of the concerned Institution. The terms and conditions of the fellowship are as follows:

1. Your fellowship will be activated from the date of issue of this DBT-JRF award letter or from the date of joining, whichever is later. The duration of the fellowship is initially for 2 years from the date of joining. The fellowship may be extended up to 5 years depending on the satisfactory progress. No further extension will be granted in future. To avail the fellowship you must accept the fellowship and report for duty within a period of two year from the date of issue of this award letter. If you do not report by this time, you will forfeit the fellowship.
2. You will be designated as "DBT-JRF" with consolidated remuneration of ₹16,000/- per month and a contingency of ₹30,000/- per year. You will be entitled to HRA, if you are not availing the institutional hostel facility as per DST guidelines applicable to research fellowships.
3. Your fellowship and contingency grant will be released to the host University/Institute after you report for duty. You must send your joining report through proper channel (Director/Registrar) and return the filled Data Sheet as early as possible after joining any Institute/University. Guidelines of the DBT-JRF fellowship and all the required forms can be downloaded from NCCS website: www.nccs.res.in.
4. You are advised to report for duty in place of your research on the 1st of the month as far as possible.
