Subject: Financial Sanction of the research project titled "Design, Synthesis and Pharmacological Evaluation of novel 4-quinolone derivatives for their potential in allergic asthma" under the guidance of Prof. Asmita Gajbhiye, Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dr. Hari Singh Gour University, Sagar-476003.

Sanction of Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB) is hereby accorded to the above mentioned project at a total cost of Rs.40,10,000/- (Rupees forty lakh ten thousand only) with break-up of Rs.10,00,000/- under Non-Recurring head and Rs.30,10,000/- under Recurring head for a duration of 4 years. The items of expenditure for which the total allocation of Rs.40,10,000/- has been approved for a period of 4 years, are given below:

2. Sanction of the SERB is also accorded to the payment of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakh only) under "Non-Recurring" and Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees four lakh only) under "Recurring" being the grant for the year 2015-16, for implementation of the above said research project.

3. The expenditure involved is debitable to "Fund for Science & Engineering Research (FSER-SC)". This release is made under "Empowerment and Equity Opportunities for Excellence in Science" program.

4. The Sanction has been issued with approval of the competent authority under delegated powers and vide Diary No. SERB/F/2419/2015-16 dated 22.03.15.

5. Sanction of the grant is subject to the condition given at the website www.serb.gov.in.

6. Overhead expenses are meant for the host Institute towards the cost for providing infrastructural facilities and general administrative support etc. including benefits to the staff employed in the project.

7. While providing operational flexibility among various subheads under head General-A, it should be ensured that not more than Rs. 1.5 lakh each should be spent for travel and contingency.
