SPORTS POLICY

Department of Physical Education:

Department of Physical Education was established by Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar (M.P.) in the year 1950. The Physical Education department caters to the Sports needs of students from all University Teaching Departments' and affiliated colleges of the University. The University striving for academic excellence, and at the same time sponsoring varieties of activities that would contribute to the wholesome development of personality and promote health among students. Sports and Games are one such area promoted by the University with an intention of ensuring Physical, Mental and Emotional Health of the Student Community. The Department is organising and conducting the sports activities on the basis of guidelines provided by the ASSOCIATION OF INDIAN UNIVERSITIES (A.I.U).

Vision:

The Department of Physical Education aims at the well-being of the student to encourage mass participation in Games & Sports for overall personality development and to explore their talents for achieving national and international level sports performance. So that the University reaches its highest glory.

Objectives:

1. To place the University among the best sporting universities in India.
2. To enhance the image and prestige of the University through sporting activities.
3. To Encourage Mass Participation in Games & Sports for overall personality development.
4. To promote students' sports participation and to create awareness about the benefits of Physical Education & Sports and to spread Sports Culture among students.
5. To provide systematic coaching programme by involving qualified & competent personnel to groom University teams & sports talent.

6. To generate good players through a harmonious blend of ancient and modern techniques and to search sports talent at the University level and to groom them as better performers.
7. To enhance our reputation as a world class Physical Education Department which is recognized for its excellence and achievements, and attracts the best students.
8. To project the potentials of the University by organizing Intercollegiate and national level University tournaments.
9. To develop adequate and standard sports infrastructure facilities like Playing Fields, Gymnasium, Swimming Pool, Track & Field, and procure quality equipment.
10. To undertake and promote research in Physical Education and Sports.
11. To involve alumni & other agencies to contribute financially to the development of Sports.

University Games and Sports Board (Committee):

The board shall be constituted as follows-

1. Honourable Vice-Chancellor
2. Chairman: Nominated by Hon'ble V.C.
3. Dean Student's welfare
4. Three President of Games and Sports Club Nominated by Hon'ble V.C.
5. One Outstanding Sportsman from among the students on rolls, nominated by the Chairman for a period of one year
6. Director of Physical Education Ex-Officio Secretary

The tenure of the Games and Sports Board will be of 02 years, which can be extended/modified/reconstituted by Honourable Vice-Chancellor.

Responsibilities & Powers of the Games and Sports Board:

1. Make arrangements and supervise the games and sports of the University and frame Rules and Regulations in this regard;
2. Frame the budget for games and sports.
3. To formulate Sports Policies of Physical Education & Sports programme from time - to - time.
4. To suggest measures for promotion of sports activities.

5. To suggest measures to carry out the sports activities according to the University budget allocation and allocation of University sports development fund for sports activities & development programmes.
6. To frame the guidelines for admission of Physical Education academic programmes and admission of students under "Sports Quota" in the University.
7. To frame the guidelines for awarding sports scholarships to outstanding sportspersons of university.
8. To revise the fee for utilization of various sports facilities (such as Gymnasium, Physiotherapy centre and Playfields) from time- to-time.
9. To approve the proposals of financial assistance for payment of T.A/D.A of players, coaches and managers of UTD and University team and other facilities provided to the students, teachers and other staff of the University.
10. To approve the proposals for organizing of the AIU tournaments.
11. Allocate finances to the various Clubs.
12. Recommend to the Vice-Chancellor the names of outstanding players and sportsmen to be nominated for admission
13. Take measures to attract the sports talent available in the university.

50% of the total members shall form the quorum for a meeting of the Committee.

UTD Sports Committee:

The UTD Sports Committee shall be constituted as follows-

Chairman	-	Director, Physical Education
Deputy Chairman	-	Assistant Director, Physical Education
Secretary	-	PTI, Physical Education Department
Members	-	Sports In charges of all schools

Every School will designate a minimum one and a maximum of five faculties as Sports Incharges from their department. He/they will be member of UTD Sports Committee and will be responsible to circulate all sports notices,

encourage students for participation and coordinate the sports activities of the School with the help of Physical Education department.

Responsibilities & Powers of the committee:

1. Organize inter school sports tournaments of various sports before schedule of intercollegiate.
2. To provide information to the students and players of all Schools.
3. To organize sports and recreation activities for teaching, administrative and non-teaching staff.
4. To organize sports activities during Gour Khel Mahotsav.
5. Coordinate all sports activities at UTD level.

Duties & responsibilities of the Department of Physical Education:

1. To Select, Train, Coach and send University teams and Individuals to participate in the Inter-University tournaments and other sports competitions which are time to time notified by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
2. To follow rules and regulation notified by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
3. To organize Inter-University and Intercollegiate competitions in various Games for the Students of the University.
4. To organize Inter-School competitions in various sports & games for the students of the University.
5. To maintain the indoor and outdoor sports infrastructure facilities in the University campus.
6. To reserve the indoor and outdoor sports infrastructure facilities on request by other agencies for conducting competitions and to collect the fee prescribed by the University.
7. To provide Physiotherapy Centre and Gymnasium facility for students, teachers, officers, non-teaching staff and outsiders and to collect the fee prescribed by the University.

8. To prepare the agenda to be discussed during the University Games and Sports Board Meeting(s).
9. To organize Workshops/ Clinics/ Seminars/ Conferences/ Referee's Examination of various Sports Activities/ Physical Education & Coaches Training Pogrammes in various sports activities by involving SAI, Universities & various sports agencies.
10. To establish and maintain Cricket Academy to provide facility and specialized training to the young talent of age group 10 to 14 years (Boys and Girls).
11. To convene University players' alumni association meeting as and when required after the formation of the association.
12. To start and manage various academic programmes of Physical Education and Sports.

General Rules:

1. The guideline and rules notified by AIU for University players/teams' participation will be followed.
2. The selection of players/teams for Various Inter-University competitions will be done by the selection committees formed by the Department of Physical Education.
3. Only bonafide, fulltime students, who are enrolled for a regular course of the University, and those who fulfill the eligibility criteria laid down by the A.I.U, New Delhi shall be eligible to take part in the selection process.
4. The selection committee will select the players and stand-byes of the University teams based on their performance during the trials/ competitions. If performance standard of any team / player is not satisfactory as felt by the selection committee members, on the recommendations of the committee such team/player may not be sent for participation in Inter-University tournaments
5. The University team's captaincy will be decided by the Director of Physical Education and selection committee constituted by the Department of Physical Education, Dr. Harisingh Gour University based on seniority/game knowledge/discipline/leadership qualities/ past participation in the University/achievements in the Inter-

University competitions and National championships/ class/age. In Ordinary conditions, any player is entitled to captain a university team in a particular Game/Event only once in his/her career.

6. If any University player misbehaves during the coaching/ Inter-University competitions, disciplinary action will be initiated by the Director of Physical Education, based on the report submitted by the team manager/coach, by way of barring the player from participating in the University Inter-Collegiate Tournaments/Inter-University Tournaments for a period of one to three years depending on the gravity of misconduct.
7. Attending University team coaching is compulsory and in case any team player(s) is/are absent for camp, stand-by(s) will be called for the camp by Director of Physical Education, however sportsperson(s) who is/are participating in the Inter-Collegiate, National or International Competitions during the University team's coaching camp may be exempted by the Director of Physical Education from attending the camp.
8. The TA/DA of University team players/mangers/coaches and other accompanying officials will be borne by the University as per the provisions made in the University Games and Sports Board from time- to- time. Money earmarked for various teams as per budget allocation will be advanced to the team manager & in turn, they shall maintain proper accounts and submit the same at the office of the Director of Physical Education on completion of team's engagement.
9. The University team mangers/coaches will be nominated by the Director of Physical Education based on their experience/ knowledge/ ability/ proficiency.
10. The University players/officials will be provided with Track Suits/Sports Wears with University logo as per the colour combination proposed by the Department of Physical Education.
11. The players who have represented University in various activities and the accompanying officials of various teams may obtain representation certificate/participation certificate signed by the Director of Physical Education, after the completion of the inter-university tournaments.
12. The players may obtain attendance certificates for the period of attending coaching camp and inter-university tournaments for

regularising their attendance in their schools, as per the university norms.

13. Officials accompanying the university teams for inter-university competitions will be issued attendance certificate on completion of assignment.
14. Physical Education Department will issue the equipments to the players for practice (Wherever required). The consumable items issued to players will be written off from the department stock register immediately and it will not be taken back. Non- consumable items shall be returned to the department store by the players in the same working condition.
15. Sports infrastructure- Higher sports performance requires specific infrastructure as per requirement of the game. The University will maintain the infrastructure and develop it according to the need of players and competition.
16. Annual budget of sports department: In every financial year the department will prepare the annual budget. The budget will be approved by the statutory Bodies of the University.
17. Intercollegiate tournament will be organized only if 3 or more potential teams participate in the tournament.
18. In case of less entries, direct selection trials for university team will be organized. In this case no kit and TA/DA will be provided to the UTD players.
