c) Doctorate (Ph.D.)

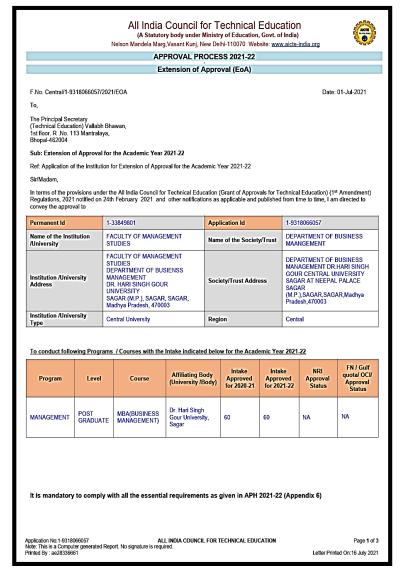
