Prof. A. D. Sharma

Professor Ambika Datta Sharma [b. 1960] is an eminent scholar and emerging Philosopher belonging to the scholastic tradition of Benares. He obtained his Master Degree [1985] and Doctor of Philosophy [1988] in Philosophy from Banaras Hindu University. He earned also the Degree of Bauddha Darshanacharya [1993] from Sampurnanand Sanskrita Vishwavidyalaya, Varanasi. He is well-versed scholar of Indian Philosophy, Buddhism, Buddhist Logic and Epistemology, Philosophy of Language, 20th Century Indian Philosophy and Cultural Studies with special reference to Colonial and Post Colonial Cultural Consciousness. He is an editor of esteemed Journal 'Unmilan' published by Darshan Pratishthan, Jaipur and Chief Editor of 'Madhya Bharti', A Journal of Humanities and Social Sciences published by Dr. Hari Singh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar (M.P.).
